

Globethics Doctoral School 2024 Yogyakarta, Indonesia

Application Period

Applications are open via https://globethics.net/courses/doctoral-school.

The application process for **online participants** is open until 21 July 2024. Online candidates will be informed of the success of their application by the end of July 2024. The application process for onsite participants is now closed.

Selection Criteria

The selection of the applicants to the first Globethics Doctoral School (GDS) 2024 in Yogyakarta, Indonesia, will be facilitated by a *Scientific Committee* composed of experts from various academic disciplines with a specialisation related to the thematic field of the Doctoral School 2024.

General Criteria

Due to unprecedented demand, a hybrid format of the Globethics Doctoral School 2024 has been developed. All 20 candidates participating in person in Yogyakarta, Indonesia will have access to an online programme, which is now open to an additional 20 candidates participating online only. Online participation in the programme is free of charge; to receive a Certificate of Completion and university credits, participants will be charged 30 USD.

The onsite GDS 2024 targets 15 international doctoral students and 5 doctoral students from Indonesia, preferably in their first or second year of doctoral studies. In addition, 20 international doctoral candidates will be invited to apply for the integrated online programme. In total, **40 doctoral candidates will be selected**.

The selection is based on competitive applications with the aim to select candidates for the GDS 2024 fulfilling the following general criteria:

- Enrolment in a doctoral programme of a higher education institution;
- Originating from different regions and representing different cultural and linguistic contexts;
- The selection will be mindful of gender balance and the inclusion of underrepresented groups to ensure broadest possible diversity within the selected participant group;
- The Doctoral School aims at preferably younger scholars. The selection committee will review the application dossiers based on their individual merit. It will consider contextual variations in academic qualification pathways and the consequences on candidates' age, and therefore refrains from pre-defining a fixed age range or limit.

Specific Criteria

- Completed doctoral research proposal in various disciplines;
- Research conducted in a field closely related to the GDS 2024 theme;
- Availability to fully focus on the taught course and research mentoring programme offered by the GDS 2024 for the entire programme duration;
- Demonstration of adequate English language proficiency to follow the core programme of the GDS 2024 offered in English (with no interpretation), and experience and interest in academic writing in English or in one of the other official languages of the Doctoral School 2024 (Bahasa, Indonesia, French, Spanish).



Required Application Dossier for Selection

Applicants are invited to submit the following documentation for the selection process alongside the completed <u>online application form</u>:

- A CV with focus on the educational background;
- Certificates, transcript(s) and doctoral programme admission letter;
- An academic recommendation letter;
- A motivation letter stating the primary interests in participating in the GDS 2024 and how the GDS 2024 will contribute to the advancement of the individual research undertaken and the international research collaboration the candidate aspires to;
- A copy of the doctoral research proposal;
- A concept note of 500 words on a contextual case study related to the GDS 2024 theme (presentation to be shared during the GDS 2024).
- A 3-minute introductory video clip on the candidate's motivation and research interests (mobile-phone quality sufficient). Please upload the video to an online platform (e.g. Vimeo or YouTube) and include the link rather than uploading the video file.
