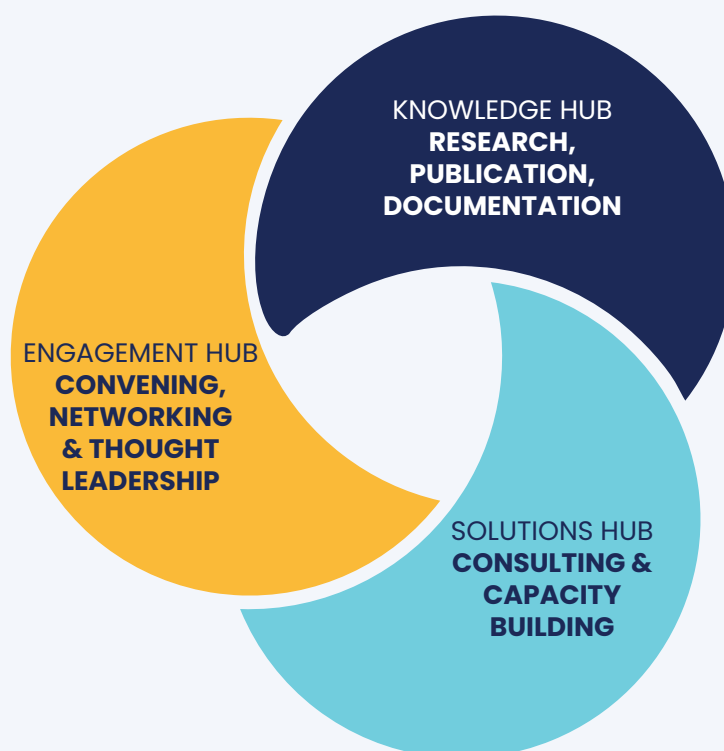

**Undesignated (core) funds and donations:** General funds and donations that are not earmarked for specific services but support the overall operations of the organisation.

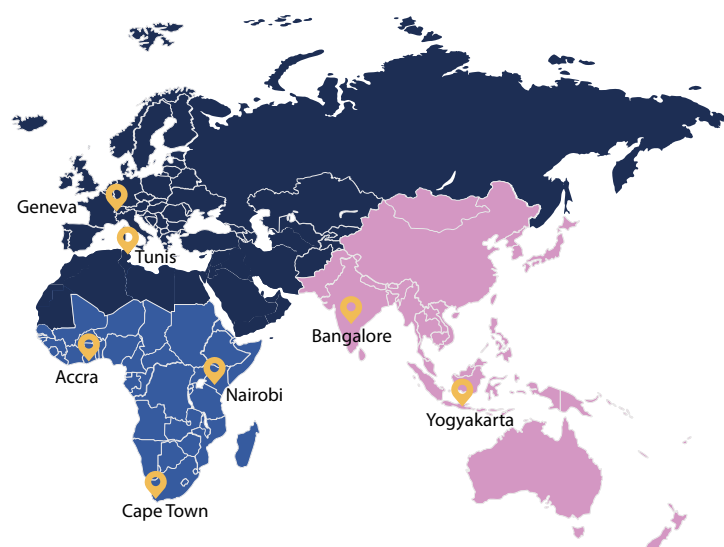

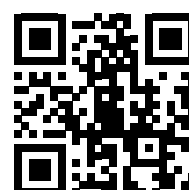
