- The maximum number of authors must not exceed three.
- Each Author will have to Register Separately.
- The abstract should not exceed 300 words.

Keywords: Provide 3-5 keywords that reflect the key topics covered in the paper.

Full Paper Submission

- The first page of the manuscript should include the title of the paper, name of the author(s), organization affiliation. complete mailing address, phone number and e-mail address.
- Tables, illustrations, charts, figures etc. should be serially numbered and duly acknowledged. Sources of the data need to be mentioned below each table.
- Only those references that are utilized should be included in the Reference List and the same should be alphabetically arranged in APA format.

- submitted work should mandatorily have a similarity index below 10%.
- · All submissions should strictly follow the given formatting style:
- · Heading: Times New Roman 14 point
- Text Font: Times New Roman 12 point
- Margin: 1 inch all sides
- Spacing: 1.5 Line Spacing, Single Column
- · References: APA Style
